What is Rakugo?

Rakugo is Japan's minimalist comic storytelling. Seated on a cushion, a performer uses just a paper fan and a hand towel to switch voices, gestures, and characters in dialogue—painting entire scenes with words.

Born in the Edo period (1600s),

these fast-paced tales mix witty wordplay

with a surprising ending (punch line)

that makes the audience laughing.

Unlike stand-up, the storyteller never stands; timing and imagination do the work.

Presented in clear English, Rakugo's humor

and warmth cross cultures effortlessly. In this 90-minute Namikiza Experience,

discover how a single voice can conjure bustling streets, quarrelling couples, and mischievous spirits before your eyes.
